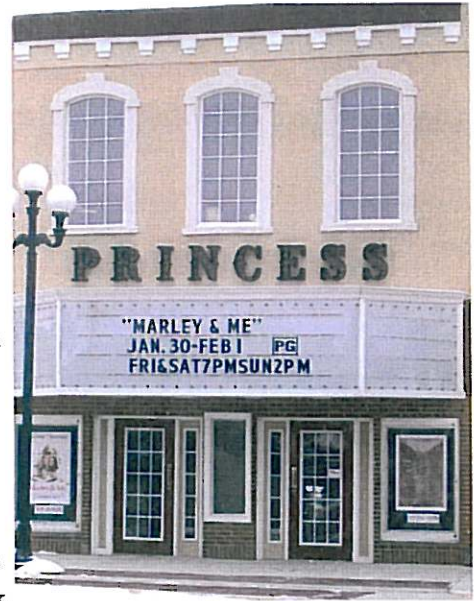
Two Cent's Worth

Please join us at the next tobacco prevention coalition meeting to add your "Two Cents"!

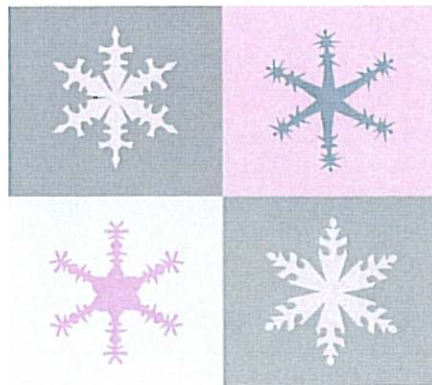


No Smoking Signs
